## Geography Residential – 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> July

Please note the following points before the Geography Residential this week:

- Weather forecast – Looking like there is going to be some showers of rain on the Wednesday but still high temperatures and lots of sunshine. Prepare for all weathers please! E.g Waterproof jacket, warm clothes, sun cream etc.
- Day of departure- Pupils to arrive between 8am at the student entrance with everything they are taking with them on the trip (suitcase/ holdall, rucksack, bedding etc)
- Pupils to arrive at school in their own clothes/ clothes suitable for the first activities in the afternoon.
- Medication needs to be in a clear bag with pupil name on it (clearly) and any instructions inside the bag. – pupils to give Mr Farquhar/Mr Ellor their medication on arrival to school- Mr Farquhar to look after it throughout the duration of the trip and will organise pupils taking medication at the right times.
- Pupils to keep hold of any blue inhalers during p1 and throughout the trip but they must tell Mr Farquhar about these when coming through the student entrance.
- Pupils with asthma will not be allowed to attend the trip if they don't have their inhaler with them.
- Any travel sickness tablets for the day of travel to be given to Mr Farquhar and will be given to the pupil before departure.
- Pupils will be in normal lessons p1 and will meet in the refectory at the end of p1 (10am)
- Pupils to leave Stockport Academy at approx. 10:00am
- Pupils are able to bring their own snacks on the trip [No snacks on the coach though!]. PLEASE NOTE: No snacks containing nuts please.
- There is a tuck shop on site which pupils will be able to access once during their trip. There is also an ice cream stop after the end of the Mam Tor walk. I would recommend no more than £10 but they do not need any money for the trip.
- Only pack clothes that you are happy to potentially get muddy and wet.
- Make sure a warm coat/waterproof is packed.
- Please pack bin bags for wet/ muddy clothes
- No spray aerosols- roll on deodorant only.
- Pupils to bring a refillable water bottle with them – absolutely essential
- Phones or any other valuables to be taken at their own risk- we cannot accept any responsibility if these are damaged or lost. We highly recommend phones are left at home and so do the YHA Centre we are staying at.
- A packed lunch is needed on day of departure only. Any pupils who are free school meals will have a grab bag from school.
- Member of staff in charge of each group will collect any phones in and lock them up safely during the day activities.
- Signal can be poor in areas at the residential site. School contact number is: **0161 286 0330**. Mr Ellor will always have a school mobile phone on him and school can reach us on this number at any time on this. We will be able to contact you should we need to.

- Please make sure you are contactable throughout the whole time we are away.
