Nellie is a five-month-old Zuchon, a cross between a Bichon Frise and a Shih-Tzu. She has a naturally calm and friendly temperament, and as a hypo-allergenic breed, she is well-suited to interacting safely with a wide range of students and staff.

Over the coming weeks and months, Nellie will begin her formal training for her role within school. As part of this, she will be slowly introduced around the Academy so that students can become familiar with her in a controlled and positive way. Once fully trained, Nellie will be working closely with our SEND department, where she will support students through a structured referral process.
