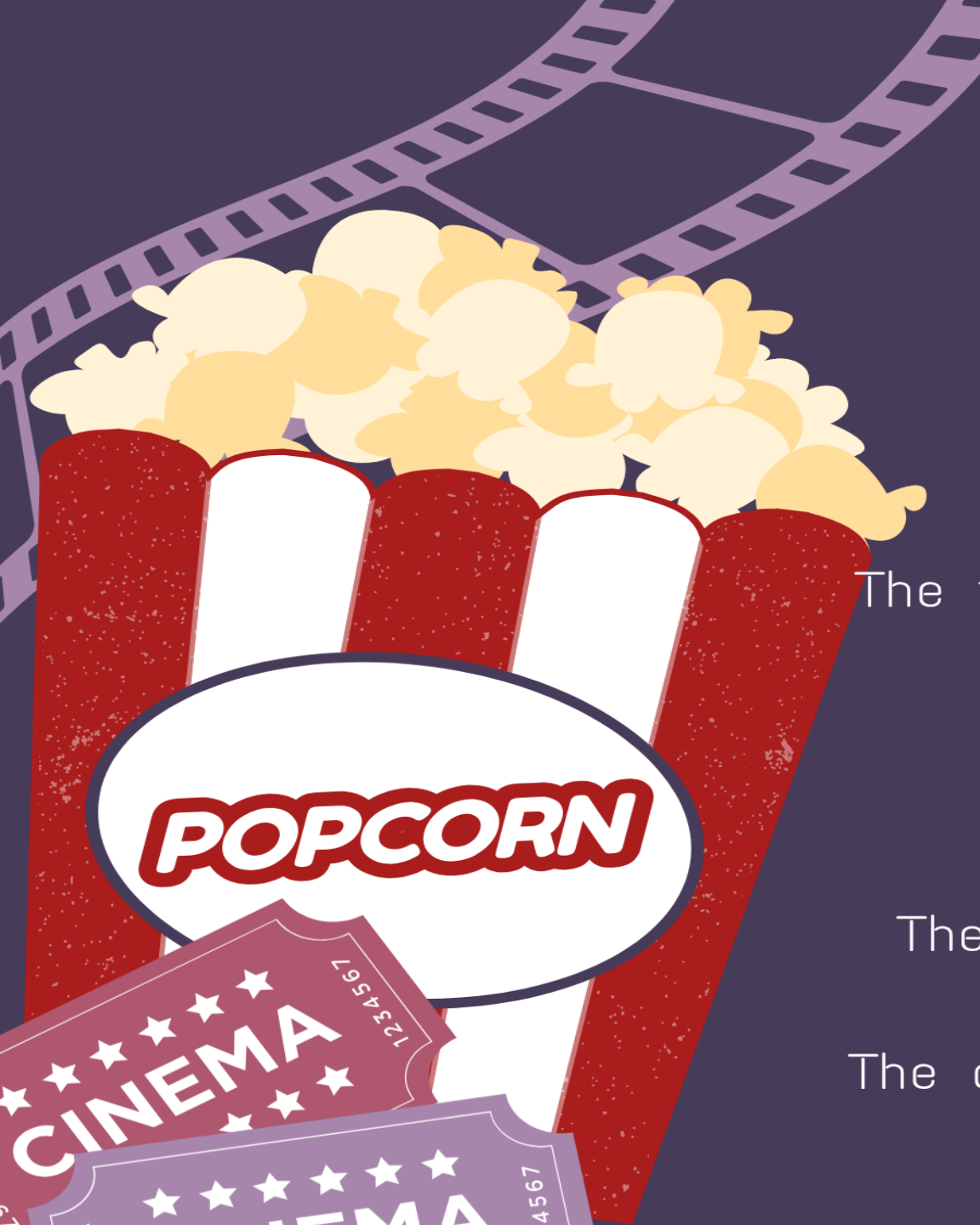

Well Done U 3 BUT, WHAT IS A 'U' RATING?

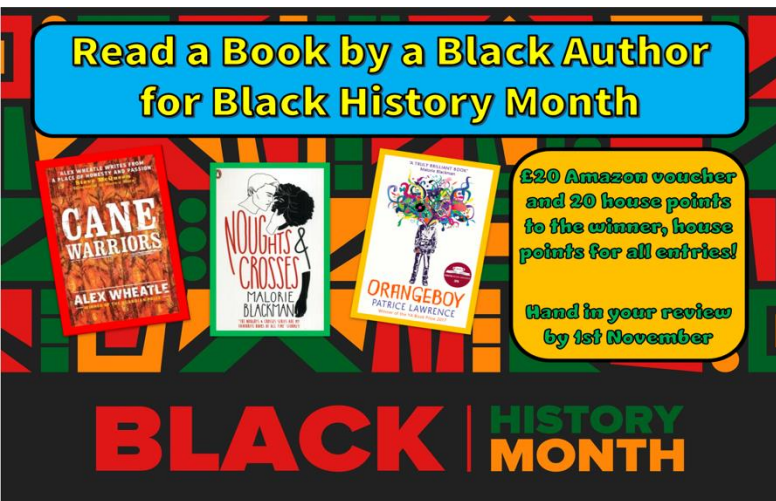
A U rating stands for 'Universal' meaning all ages can enjoy the film.

Students should not be wearing their own badges on their blazer that have not been given out by school

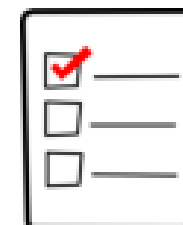


Co-curricular club sign up **Half Term 2**

We will be trialling a new sign up method for clubs for half term 2.

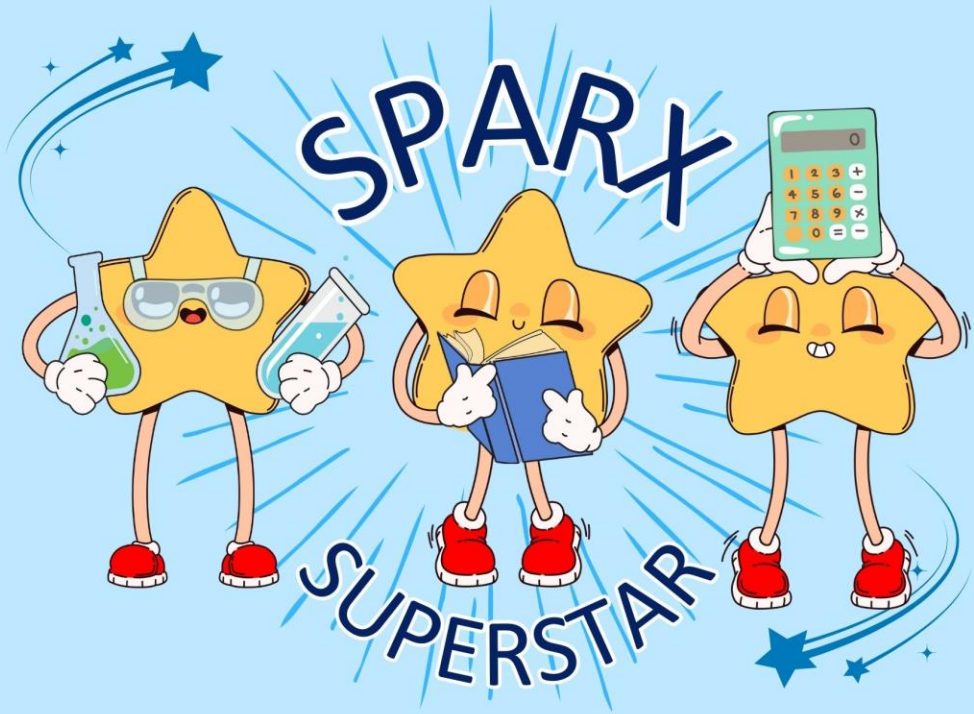
All students will receive a Microsoft form by the end of this week to sign up for clubs for next half term.

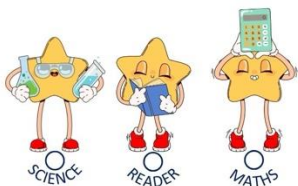
Collect Sparx postcards from your Science, English & Maths teachers
