Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our ongoing commitment to ensuring that every pupil receives the right support at the right time, we are currently reviewing all pupil movement passes that allow students to leave class or move around school outside of normal transitions. To ensure fairness, consistency, and effective support, all temporary movement passes will expire on **Friday 13 February**.

If your child currently has a pass as part of their SEND provision, the SEND team will automatically renew these and review them periodically. Our aim is always to ensure that the support your child receives is appropriate, targeted, and beneficial.

From this point onward, all movement passes will be issued only through the SEND department, following a clear referral and assessment process. This will help us ensure that passes are used appropriately and are provided to pupils who will benefit from them - for medical, sensory, or emotional reasons - based on up-to-date evidence.
