Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 9 Enterprise Day @ Stockport County F.C. on Friday 27 March 2026

As the end of the term approaches, the Year 9 students now have their enterprise day coming up and will be taking part in a "Football Masterclass" at Stockport County's home ground Edgeley Park, Hardcastle Road, Stockport SK3 9DD.

Students do not need to have knowledge or an interest in football to take part or enjoy this day. The theme of the day is based on football but the format is similar to the other enterprise days that the students have taken part in previously: the day begins with a set of team building games; students are then introduced to various problems where they compete in groups; ultimately ending with presentations and prize giving for the winners.

To assist in the smooth running of the day please note the following points below:

- **Date of the trip:** Friday 27 March 2026
- **Departure time & Means of Transport:** Students are expected to make their **own way** to Edgeley Park and must arrive between 08:15 and **no later than 08:30**. Should students arrive after 08:30 the Academy will arrange for students to be picked up and transported to school on late arrival. **No student will be allowed to participate in the event should they arrive after 08:30.**

The conference room where the event will be taking place is in the Cheadle Stand. As such, students should go to the **main car park and look for the glass box entrance** (with 1883 above it). If dropping off/picking up and the main car park is full, parents/carers can use the railway end car park as an alternative.

- **Home time:** Students will be dismissed at the normal school time of **14:55** and again will be expected to **make their own way home**. It is parental responsibility to safeguard arrangements for student travel to and from the venue.
- **Cost of the trip:** There is no charge for this visit.
- **Clothing:** Students will be **expected to wear school uniform** for the duration of the day.
- **Food:** Students will need to bring their **own packed lunch, drinks and snacks for the day**. Any student on free school meals will have a packed lunch provided for them on the day.
- **Consent to attend:** Consent for your child to attend must be given under the trips section of the Arbor app **by no later than Wednesday 25 March**.

- **Medical/Dietary Needs**

We will use the information previously provided on the school's Arbor system in relation to medical conditions or dietary requirements so please check the Arbor app to ensure that these are up to date, along with any contact telephone numbers in case we should need to contact you during the trip.

Students requiring an inhaler or emergency rescue medication such as EpiPens should ensure that they bring their own medication and carry it with them at all times.

No other medication can be carried by students. If any medication is likely to be needed during the trip, this should be handed to the trip leader, in the original, named box with a completed medical consent form which can be collected from reception or Mr Farquhar should you need one.
