### Schedule for Wednesday 3rd September

- **Year 7:**
  - Arrival time: **8:25am** via the **Sports Hall**
  - Induction sessions: **Periods 1–3**
  - Normal lessons resume: **Periods 4–5**
- **Years 8–11:**
  - Arrival time: **11:15am** via the **Student Entrance** (gates open at 11:10am)
  - Form period: **Period 3**
  - Normal lessons resume: **Periods 4–5**

### Thursday 4th September

All year groups should arrive at the normal start time of **8:25am**.

- **Back gates** open at **8:00am** for **Magic Breakfast** (free breakfast available for all students)
- **Front gate** opens at **8:15am**

Please ensure your child arrives promptly and takes advantage of our Magic Breakfast facilities.

### Uniform and Equipment Reminders

Please take a moment to review our **school uniform policy**, available on our school website. Key reminders include:

- All students must be in **full school uniform** from **Wednesday 3rd September** onwards.
- **Jewellery, false nails, painted nails, and lashes are not permitted.**
