NHS Safari Taster Day.

We are delighted to offer your child the opportunity to attend a trip to Stockport Town Hall for the NHS Safari Taster day experience.

This trip is designed to support students studying Health and Social Care in being able to apply their knowledge to relevant practice whilst also talking to professionals who work within the NHS Health and Social Care sector to explore a range of career pathways.

The trip details are as follows:

Date of Trip: 30th September 2025

Departure Time: 9.30am. Students should get their mark for form and make their way to the refectory for 9am.

Means of Transport: Coach

Arrival Time Home: 12:30. Students will be back in school for approximately 1pm. They should attend their period 4 and 5 lessons as usual.

Cost of Trip: Free

Consent to attend

Consent for your child to attend must be given under the trips section of the Arbor app.

Clothing

Students should wear their full school uniform.

Food

Students will return to school in time for lunch time.



Medical/Dietary Needs

We will use the information previously provided on the school's Arbor system in relation to medical conditions or dietary requirements so please check the Arbor app to ensure that these are up to date, along with any contact telephone numbers in case we should need to contact you during the trip.

Students requiring an inhaler or emergency rescue medication such as EpiPens should ensure that they bring their own medication and carry it with them at all times.

No other medication can be carried by students. If any medication is likely to be needed during the trip, this should be handed to the trip leader, in the original, named box with a completed medical consent form which can be collected from reception or Mr Farquhar should you need one.
