Prefectural Board Applications

We are excited to share the process for Year 10 students to apply for a position on the **Prefectural Board** for the 2025–2026 academic year. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to develop leadership skills, represent the student body, and demonstrate their commitment to the school community.

Application Process

Applying for a place on the Prefectural Board is similar to applying for a job and should be treated professionally. Please see the key points below:

1. Professional Standards

Students are expected to submit a well-presented, spell-checked application using professional language. They should refer to our *Future Me – Education with Character* programme for keywords and values that will support their application.

2. Submission Deadline

Applications must be handed in to Miss Stirling in person or emailed to her at:

Deadline: 5:00pm on Monday 16th June 2025

3. Shortlisting

All applications will be reviewed, and students will be shortlisted for interview based on the quality of their submission.

4. Interviews

Students who are shortlisted will be invited to a 30-minute interview with Mrs McCann, where they will discuss their experiences at school and the personal qualities they can bring to the role.

5. Outcome

Students will be informed of the result via email. Successful applicants will be awarded either a **Gold** or **Silver** Prefect tie, depending on the strength of their application and interview.

The Role of a Prefect

Being part of the Prefectural Board means being an active leader and role model across the school community. Responsibilities include:

Aspiration

- Leading and presenting to both students and staff
- Taking part in student council and house meetings

Respect

- Being a positive role model both in and out of school

Community

- Assisting at key school events such as parents' evenings, open evenings, and school productions
- Supporting house groups to organise and run events and competitions
