Dear Parent/Carer,

At Stockport Academy we have a **student reward charter** to reward students who consistently maintain the high standards we desire. This charter runs each term and resets at the beginning of the next term. In KS4, the charter consists of 5 areas; Independent study, attendance, Negative house points (excluding homework and lates), Lates (to school and lesson) and house competitions entries.

Students need to achieve all criteria in the column to be able to achieve Gold, Silver or Bronze. For example, if a student has 5 silver and 1 gold, they will achieve Silver for that term.

Rewards

If a student meets all of the gold criteria, they will be rewarded with an external trip (free of charge), a certificate and a badge.

If a student meets all of the silver criteria, they will be rewarded with an internal reward (free of charge), a certificate and a badge.

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If a student meets all of the bronze criteria, they will get a certificate and a badge.

Charter dates 26/27

Term 1 will run from 21st September to 4th December

Term 2 will run from 4th January to 12th March

Term 3 will run from 12th April to 12th July

The data is analysed during the weekend following the deadline. Your child will then receive their achievement at the beginning of the next week. They have 2 days to go and challenge their achievement of the charter if they feel a mistake has been made. Following this, the final number of students is finalised with the trip providers and we are unable to make any changes.
