Dear Parent/Carer,

At the Academy, we are incredibly lucky to have an extensive co-curricular activities programme. There are a large range of clubs which happen before school, during lunch time and after school.

Our expectation is for all Year 7, 8 and 9 students to attend 2 clubs per week. Students require club attendance marks to meet our student reward charter. During term 1 (September to December) students need to achieve 12 or more club session attendance marks to meet the gold criteria; 10 or more for silver and 8 or more for bronze. There are also a variety of rewards for students who attend the most clubs throughout the year.

Students have been able to express their interest for all of our half term one clubs this week. The co-curricular sign faire happened on Wednesday 10th September and then following this, students have been able to express interest for clubs on Thursday 11th and Friday 12th September with staff throughout the school including Heads of Year, pastoral managers, club leaders, teaching assistants and myself.

Most clubs begin next week (w/c 15th September) unless stated otherwise. Over the next few days, you will see clubs begin to appear on your child's Arbor timetable if they have signed up and been successful in gaining a place for half term 1. Some clubs had a high volume of sign ups and therefore we have had to use a random generator to select the first group of participants. If your child has not been successful in gaining a place this term, they will have another opportunity later in the later. If no clubs appear on your child's timetable, they have either not signed up or not been successful in gaining a place on the club they signed up for due to limited number of places.

If any students have not signed up or would like to join additional clubs they can either speak to myself, their form tutor or the club leader to see if there are spaces available in the clubs they are interested in. You can find a copy of our timetable for half one on our school website and also on our co-curricular display board in the atrium within school.
